God seven hundred and sixteen and in the second year of the Reigne
of our Sovereign Lord George of Great Britain France and Ireland King
Defender of the Faith &c. Between Robert Taylor of the County of Accomack
in Virginia Planter of the one Part and Henry Armitrading of the same
Place Planter of the other Part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of
six thousand pounds of Tobacco to me in hand paid at and before the
making and delivery of these presents by the said Henry Armitrading the
receipt whereof he the said Robert Taylor doth hereby acknowledge him-
self therewith fully satisfied and paid and thereof and of every part
and parcell thereof doth clearly acquit & discharge and discharge
the said Henry Armitrading his heirs Executors and Assigns for ever by
these presents: hath given granted aliened Bargained sold Enfeoffed
confirmed and by these presents doth fully clearly and absolutely give
grant Bargain sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Henry
Armitrading his heirs and Assigns for ever thirty four Acres of Land
more or less situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Accomack
in the woods being the said Land and Plantation whereon the said Robert
Taylor now lives and is the remaining part and parcell of a Dividend of two
hundred twenty four Acres of Land purchased by the said Robert Taylor of
John With. late of the aforesaid County of Accomack deceased: and Bounded as
followeth: viz: Beginning at a white oak tree as specified in the Plot of the whole
two hundred twenty four Acres of Land, and from thence by a line of more
less running nearly north westerly to a Pine marked on three sides and
thence running southerly to Burtons Corner Tree, and then up the branch
