joyfull Resurrection In and through the merits of my Redemeer and for my
worldly Goods and Estate both Real & Personal after just debt and fine:
all charges paid I give as follows

I Give unto my Eldest son named Robert my Bay horse
I Give unto my Youngest son named Fenton Blare my Gray horse
I Give unto my Eldest son aforesaid my best feather bed with Curtains
and valance and all its furniture as also my hand mill. I Give
unto my said Son two Cows and two Sheep with their Enclosure as

as also the value of a thousand pounds of tobacco in Leather as also my gun and Six yds of Druggett and trimming — I give unto my youngest son Fenton Bleare a fether Bed with its furniture two Coves and two Sheep with their increase as also the value of a thousand pounds of tobacco in Leather and twelve yds of this Country Broad Cloath — I give unto my Eldest daughter Elizabeth one spinning wheel that is to say a Linen wheel two Coves two Sheep and their increase one pewter dish and a fourth part of a thousand pds of tobacco in Leather — I give unto my second daughter margrett one Linen wheel two Coves two Sheep and their increase one pewter dish and her fourth part of a thousand pounds of tobacco in Leather — I give unto my third daughter named Hannah two Piping pens one Cabbard two Coves to Sheep and their increase and her fourth part of a thousand pd of tobacco in Leather and my little pott — I give unto my youngest daughter named Agnes the biggest pott a pair of fire tongs three Coves two Sheep and their increase and her fourth part of a thousand pounds of tobacco in Leather and for the remaining part of my Estate not here mentioned I give the same to my six Children to be Equally divided betwixt them and my will and desire is that my said Children shall be disposed of and taken care for by my honored father in Law Capt. Moses Fenton and my mother in Law Margaret Fenton and I do hereby constitute nominate and appoint my Trusty and well beloved friend Robert Mills to be the Executor of this my last will and Testament in Testimony that this is my last will and Testament I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this eight day of February anno 1717
