Planter being sick and weak of body but of sound memory prayed be God for the
same and being mind full of the uncertainty of this Life do hereafter make and
ordain this to be my will & Testament revoking all other will or wills by me
formerly made

I hereby I commit my body to the earth to be bound at the discretion of God and
soul to God that gave it, hoping through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ
to escape a full and free pardon for all my sins and to enjoy a place among
the elect in endless happiness and for what worldly estate the Lord will
this Mary hath been pleased to bestow upon me, I be flow in manner
and form following all my just debts being first paid

I give my son Jack dip two hundred acres of Land part of the deceased of
five hundred acres of Land on which I now dwell including my new dwelling
plantation and Orchard it being layd out by Edward Lear Jugh in plot
bearing date the thirteenth day of June 1709 the fored two hundred acres of
Land I give to my son Jack dip to him and his heirs for ever

I give to my son John dip one hundred and fifty acres of Acres of Land
next joying to my son Jack and part of the afored five hundred acres
out in plot by Edward Learborough it day & year afored it fored hundred & fifty
Acres of Land I give to my son John dip to him and his heirs for ever

I give to my son Jacob dip all the remainder part of my Land it being layd
out by plot as afored to him & his heirs for ever

My will is of my dear & L. wife pasthore dip for and during his widowhood
remain and be in peaceable and quiet possession of the one moiety or on half
of this my now dwelling plantation to gather with all the rights profits &
benefits thereunto belonging but in case shee marries then to have but
third parts

I give unto my above d. wife my gray mare Doney together with y.
Bridle & saddle I bought last year

My will is that my son Jack dip be at age immediately after my
decease to enjoy and possess what above given him except if I provide
and benefitt given to my wife

I give my son Jack dip my trooper top and my Gun and barrow
I give unto my son John dip & Phillip my will is that my son send
him to the age of Eighteen if the white will in daver
to learn him the arte of Shoemaking and then to all full age to gett his
own living

I give unto my above d. wife one new feather, 100 Shells, Rugg and 1 Blankett one
pillow now belonging to it. I bed I give my wife dip hundred pounds of Tobacco to be
employed to her Williams head also I give my wife my foot plow

I give to my daughter Mary dip 1 feather bed, 1 blanket, 1 Rugg, 1 Blankett and
1 chest I also give my daughter my son new sett of petter dishes and 2 petter
Basons of d. middle size which I bought last

I give unto my daughter Eli dip 1 feather bed, 1 blanket, 1 Rugg I also give
my daughter 2 petter and 2 Basons as above

My will is that my above d. wife lay out of value of one thousand
pounds of Tobacco for y. Clothing of d. Children

My will is that all the remaining parts of my Estate of what kind soe
ever be Equly divided between my above d. wife and my three Children viz
my son Mary dip Eli dip by my two sisters and y. d. sister sell y. d. sister
my Childrens part of d. living Estates for w. they can be layd up for Marys
use meaning my Childrens

My will and pleasure is that my daughter be and Remain with me to Brother
& Mary Nickson till she arives at the age of Eighteen
My will is that my son Jacob have with my son Jack till he comes to the
age of Eighteen and then to Receive his Estate and that my daughter Eli
live with my son till shee come to d. age of sixteen & then to Receive her share
My will is of my trustes baston & putt my son will to learn they please till
he arive at d. age of Eighteen y. to Receive his Estate

I do appoint my trusty and well be loved friends Tho: Enams & John Barms to
see this my will performed, appointing my beloved wife my whole and sole Exe
= cutrip of this my Last will & Testament Revoking all former wills what soe ever as
witness my hand & seal this 11 day of March 1718 to the other side: John Dip
Seal & hand & so in the presence of my wife & my son Jack dip
