that I have to stay on Earth do hereby make Substitute and appoint  
this to be my Last will & Testament in manner & form following  
my Soule I bequeath to almighty God who gave it soaping he  
will be released to accept it through the merits & Intercession  
of my Blessed Saviour & Redemeon the Lord Jesus Christ & my body  
to grave to be buried with Christian burial at d. discretion  
my Executor bear after mentioned and as for what worldly  
goods God of his In infinite mercy hath bin pleased to be letton on me  
I give and bequeath in manner and form following vizt—  
I give and bequeath unto the poor of Accomack County twenty  
five pounds to be disposed of at d. discretion of d. Church Wardens  
I give and bequeath unto my loving brother Maurice Stephen  
all my Wealing Cloaths and to his son John Stephen my part  
of the Spooner which I have part of with Maurice Stephen  
and Robert Anderson — I am I give and bequeath unto Abigail  
Bailey wife of Richard Bailey fifteen pounds and to Sarah  
Laker daughter of Luke Laker deceased fifteen pds to be paid to  
them out of my personal Estate in Cloathing as they have  
auation not exceeding five pounds money due to each —  
I give and bequeath unto Naomy Rodgers ten pounds and to Thomas  
Hall and Michael Hall ten pounds to each of them to be paid  
out of my personal Estate to be paid to the said Thomas &  
Michael when they shall be of age to Recieve their Estates —  
I give and bequeath unto Hancock Nickell my Servtone —  
I give and bequeath my Plantation and all the preivilg thereunto  
belonging to my first born Son of Mathew Vandegrift called and  
known by the name of Obidiah Vandegrift to him & his heirs  
for ever and for want of such heirs to go to my heirs at common  
Law not Excluding John Stephen —  
I give and bequeath my whole Estate Excepting the Legacies  
above mentioned both Real & personal to be Equally deviced betw.  
on the first born Son of Rebecca Pratt she is now wife of Willcock  
Johnson called & known by the name of John and Obidiah Van-  
degrift Son of Mathew Vandegrift to be Equally deviced  
between them when they shall drive at the age of eighteen  
years Further my will is that all the Legacies above given be  
paid out of my personall Estate and that the Court approul the  
wife and d. discreet men to appraise my Estate — Further my will  
is that if either obidiah the Son of Martha Vandegrift or John  
the son of Rebecca should die before they be eighteen years of age  
that then the other posses and in Toy my whole Estate both Real  
and personal which is not disposed of in my will And I doe here  
make Constitute & approve Hancock Nickell whole & Sole  
Executor of this my will to see all things done in contrained per-  
form according to my desire in witness whereof I have unto set
