pillows & feathers to fill them and one two year old heifer & one
large pater dish & one middle sized dish and one pater plate

faced one & one Brindled & one feather Bed and furniture and one two year old
Bull and one new Iron pott holding bote nine Gall & one middle sized pater dish
& 2 pater 2 pater plates & 2 porringers & one great dish & one new pewter tank-
-ard & one salt seller & one Mustard Box & one two year old Hores w. a Blare
in his forehead & one Gray Horse for use of my wife and all my
Children as long as they shall stay with her & one new pater chamber pott

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son John James one Black Cow with white spots
in her Rigg with calf and one new Iron Kettle holding about four or five
Gall & large dish & one middle sized dish pater & one pater plate & one small
gun new Pocket & locked & my Riding saddle and all my warring Cloaths
& all my shoe Makers tools

I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Joshua one two year old heifer & one
feather bed and bolster & two pillows and one Iron pott holding about five or
six Gall & one large pater dish & one middle sized pater dish & one por-
-ringer and one pater plate

And further my will is that all my Hogs may be Equally divided Between my
wife and all my Children when they come to Age my will also is that in case
my wife marries then my Sons to be att age and Receive their Estates att &
-teen but in case she Remains unmarried then they shall stay until
they attain to w. Age of twenty one years my will allow is that my
-leather may all be Equally divided between my wife & all my Children
and all my Earthen wares to be Equally divided between my wife & Children
my will also is that if fourteen hundred & eighty pence w. is due to me to be
paid in Bat and Pork may be Equally divided between my wife & Children

Further my will is that I do Appoint my loving wife Mary James & my
Son John James my whole and sole Executors & Assigns of this my last will &
-testament Signed with my hand and sealed with my seal this 14 day of February in
w. year of our Lord God 1721
