In the Name of God amen this second day of June 1728 I Joseph Gouty of the County
of Accomack in the Colony of Virginia being sick and weak in body but of sound and perfect
sense and memory thanks be to Almighty God for it. I do there make and ordain this my
last will and Testament as followeth first and principally I recommend my soul into
the hands of my Creator and redeemer that gave it me and my body to be decently buried at
the discretion of my Executors and my worldly Estate as followeth. Item I give and bequeath to
my well beloved wife Elizabeth Gouty one Cow and Calf and one Mair called Kettle and six
Spewter plates and one Spewter dish also my biggest Iron Spott and kettle Boone Chest that
she callers Chest and half the Indian Corn that is made upon my Plantation this pres-
ent year and the third part of the Wheat and all the rest of my Estate that is not men-
tioned and set down in this my will except my fishing boat. Item I give and bequeath
to my brother John Gouty all my wearing woolling Cloaths and one brindle heifer &
one feather Bed and new dutch blanket and one rug and one old dutch Blankett
and old sheet and boat Sail and the Chest called my Chest and old Chest as it stands and
one meat Sifter and bedstead and one Iron Spott that is now at Darby Macarters and
six Spewter plates and one Spewter dish and one milk pann one Drinking cup
and Drinking glass and 3 glass bottles and a Sow pig and bore pig of my English
Sow and ~~my~~ my harrow hoes and half the Buckells and Tubbs about my house
and half my working hoes and Iron Pestle Item I give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth Gouty one Two year old heifer that runs at Darby Macarters unmarked
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Gouty one fildie heifer and four
Spewter plates and my largest Spewter dish and my least Iron Spott and one feath-
er bed and bolster all to be delivered to her at the day of Marriage or at sixteen
Years of age and my will is that my wife shall have it in her possession till
the time my daughter arrives to the age and then to be paid to her in as good
Condition as they are at this time. Item I give and bequeath to my brother John
Gouty six turn'd Trunchers and a Saddle tree and Leather and all other things suitable to
make a Saddle further my will is that my brother John Gouty pay all my just Debts out of
what is given to him and with is due to me not taking any thing from my wife

1) That is given to her and if he refuse so to relinquish what is given to him in this my will then my will is that if my brother John Gouty die before my will is proved that what is here given to him shall to my wife and Children I do ordain and appoint my well beloved brother John Gouty and my well beloved friend John Tanhard my sole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament as witness my hand the day and year above set down

to be buried after a Christian manner at the Discretion of my friends. Item I give & be-
queath unto my beloved wife Edmunds memory Shepherds three negros called miles & Robm
& Patience also I give to my wife the half of my land & houses & on hands & one half of my
~~land & houses~~ still during Her widowhood & then to ~~revert~~ to my son John Shepherds
Item I give to my son John Shepherds six negros Called Robin & Ann & Tafflet Rahab
& Daniell & Rachel to him his heirs or assigns I give to my son John Shepherds
one Negro called tanner after the Death of my wife I give unto my son John Shepherds
Plantation I now live on Luluait and lying on the south side of nandua to him his
heirs or assigns for ever also I give to my son John the half of the mill belonging to me
and Robt Andrews I give to my son John my part of the Sloop I Item I give to my son
John Shepherds four feather Beds & furniture & two suits of Cartrains & Vailens also my
large Looking Glass and one Wimsut Cubard & also my new Chest of draws & one Dozen
of Plates and half a Dozen of Dishes that is to say Pewter and one ovelt Table & one
Square Table & two Iron Potts & one Spill and one Table Cloath & one Dozen of napkins
that is Diaper & two Chits and one Dozen of Chairs, Item I give to my son John Shepherds
fourteen Head of Cattle old and Young also I give to my son John my black Horse called
mars & one Gray horse called King and also one Dozen of Sheep I give to my son
John one ^{small} pair of Sillyards and all the rest of my Estate I give to my Beloved Wife
Edmunds memory Shepherds not before mentioned Lastly I do appoint my beloved wife & son
to be my whole ~~last~~ ^{sole} Executors of this my last will and Testament Revoking all other wills
