I Commit to the dust from whence it came to be buried in decent
manner and as touching such worldly estate whereof it hath pleas-
ed God to bestow upon me I give and dispose of that same in
manner and forme following

I give unto Brand Fletcher my plantation whereon now I
live one hundred and fifty acres more or les to him and
his Ayres for ever and in case he should dy without off-
spring

to William Fletcher and his ayers for ever
I give unto William Fletcher one quilt and also ten yards of Bead licking
I give unto Batterton Fletcher fifty acres of Land lying between Dancorex
Browns his line and William Fletcher to him and his ayers & in life he
should dy without issue then to William Fletcher and his ayers for ever
I give to each of my Sisters that is Elizabeth touch and Mary Croucher
frankes Racket five pinter plates a piece
I give unto Philip Parker Junior one Cypre brace Cattle, I give unto
Winifred Parker three iron pinter do's. I give unto Brandon Fletcher
my mare called peg. I give unto William Fletcher my Saddle & Curb
Bridle; I give unto Batterton Fletcher five oxes and one mare Cattle
I give to Mary Croucher one large iron pot
I give unto Frances Racket one small iron pot
I give unto Elizabeth touch one frying pan
I give unto William Fletcher two haws and two Calves
I give unto Batterton Fletcher one bed bolster rug and Blankets
I give unto Thomas Fletcher one Tankard & small Copen and three plates
I give unto William Fletcher all my Sheare of Thor and oyle also one
browd up to William Fletcher
I give my best sute of Cloaths and hat to Brandon Fletcher and all
