 present dangerously sick & weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory, thanks be given
 unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that
 it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & obtain this my last will
 Testame^{nt} of D. to say, principally & first of all I give & recommend my Soul unto the
 hands of God of glory, & for my Body I recommend it to the Earth, to be buried
 in a Christian like & decent manner, at D. discretion of my Executors hereafter
 mentioned, nothing doubting but at D. general Resurrection I shall receive it
 again by D. mighty power of God, & touching such worldly Estate where with I
 hath blessed God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in D. following
 manner
 I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Andrews my dearly beloved wife / whom I like wife constitute
 make & ordain my Executrix to gother with my loving & well beloved friend, Capt. John B. B.
 and Nathaniel Curtis to be advising & assisting to her in spending this my last will &
 Testament, my negro boy named Coffy to be freely possessed & enjoyed by during her Natural
 life & at her decease, I give & bequeath my above said boy Coffy to my wellbeloved daughter
 Elizabeth Andrews & to D. heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever like I give & bequeath
 to my above said wife Elizabeth after my just & Lawfull debts are paid, all my household
 goods & moveables together with all my Creatures what ever excepting such household
 goods moveables & Creatures as I shall give & bequeath to D. several passing here
 after mentioned, Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth
 + new my negro woman named Hannah with all her issue, and to the heirs of
 my D. daughter Elizabeth lawfully begotten for ever excepting D. first Child of my
 D. Negro Hannah shall bear, & I shall live to D. age of two years, I give & bequeath
 begotten for ever likewise I give & bequeath to my above said daughter Elizabeth
 the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever above said daughter Elizabeth
 hundred Acres lying near Pocomuck road bounded between a tract of Land containing
 belonging to Joseph Stagon & Daniel Shear bought by me from Mr. Richard
 & made over to me by Mr. William Randall as the deed of sale more fully
 bears, Likewise I give & bequeath to my D. daughter Elizabeth one good full
 Bed, one better two pillow & pillow caps, one pair of black more full
 Blankets, one silk mugg one pair of green flannel Bushy Druggs Pantans, w.
 sleeves conform, one bedstead, & bed cord, eight new pewter dishes, six
 Porringers, two new basons, six new plates, one new Tankard two small porring
 one dozen pewther spoons, one large great pott two other potts all Iron, one
 dozen Diaper Napkins, w.th one Table Cloth, diaper, two diaper towels, one green
 chest, one small Trunk, one Sorrel Mare & her Suckle, six Cows & six
