September 12th day anno 1719

In the Name of God Amen I owing Minion of the County aforesaid being very sick of body but of perfect memory thanks be to God doe make this my last will & Testament in manner and form as followes first of all I do leave my soul to God that gave it and to Christ my Redeemer in whose merits I trust to find Redemption & secondly I commit my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors

Firstly I doe Give one mare and mare Colt to Ruse her and her increase equally between my Loving wife Margaret Minion and Rowland Hodgson which said mare is to be taken of the Island where they now are at this present fall by the D. Rowland Hodgson for then the aforesaid Hodgson is supposed to sell them. any of their increase yielding to the aforesaid Margaret half of the pay or profit.

Secondly I do Give and bequeath to my Godson Joshua Lang one two year old heifer her and her increase with a heifer is to be moved of the Island where they now are

thirdly I doe Give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Hodgson two heifers the one to be delivered forth with which is a Red three year old heifer at the next spring and the other to be two year old and to be paid at her Grand mother's death

Fourthly I do leave my Loving Daughter Ann but twelve pence to keep her for any other part of my Estate what soever

Lastly I do Give and bequeath all and singular of my Goods and Chattels that it has been pleased God to bestow on me as horses and Cattell and Sheep and hogs and plows and harrows finally all that does belong to me either in the house or without. does to my Dear & Loving wife Margaret Minion and do make & constitute her my whole and sole executrix to keep and enjoy all that is mine during her naturall life without disturbance or hindrance of any person what soever and at her decease to be left as she pleases

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Loving wife Pattience and my Child all my moveables Estate and if my daughter Mary Owen dyeth without issue I Give and bequeath my Land and plantation unto my youngest Brother Peter Owen to him & his Heirs for ever

Item I doe will & make my deare and Loving wife Pattience to be my sole executrix of this my last will and Testament disannulling all other wills dees or deeds whatsoever as witness My hand and Seal this twentieth fourth day of April anno one thousand seven hundred & twenty

 my State of what kind soever during her Nat^lall Life then to be
 Equally divided between my son Edward & my daughter only: but if
 wth case my wife doth marry before her decease then my will is y^t
 my son Edward & my daughter only: shall be immediately possessor
 of the fore^s Remaining part of my State: Item my will is y^t if
 my loving wife should marry or die before my Childred should
 come of age then my sons to be at their own disposing at wth
 age of Eighteen years: & my daughters at wth age of fourteen
 years: Lastly I doe ordaine & appoint my loving wife Mary
 Gunter be my whole & sole executrix wth my Last will
 & Testament wth Records I sett my hand this ninth day of october
