 this my last will and Testament revoking and hereby disannulling all former
 wills and Testaments whatsoever by me formerly made and do publish and

This Indenture made this third day of June In the year of our Lord one thousand

 of Robert Bayly deceased of the other part: Witnesseth that I the said Richard Ketton with
 my wife: for Divers good causes and valuable Consideration, by us already Recourd: was
 Moving, have granted bargained sold confirmed Enjoyned Assigned Allocated and Delivered
 doe by these Presents Grant bargain sell confirm Enjoyned Assigne Allocated and Delivered unto
 the said Mary Bayly her heirs Executors Admrs and Assignes forever a parcel of Land
 containing one hundred Acres situate lying and being in the County of Accomack
 aforesaid Near the head of Gargaphia branch: beginning at a marked Gum In
 near branch: thence Running North west down the said branch one hundred and fifty
 poles: unto a marked Pine thence South west by a line of marked trees unto Gargaphia
 =his branch: thence North west unto the fork of the said branch: thence Southward by
 Eighty three degrees: w of e by fifty eight poles: unto a Corner marked Gum: Parting
 from Thomas Crippen Land: thence along the said of the said Crippen by marked
 North west Sixty six poles unto a Corner pine parting this from the land of the above
 said Bayly: thence North east one hundred and twenty six poles a long the Bayly
 Land: unto the place where it first began it being part of the aforesaid Richard
 and Mary Ketton's fourteen hundred acres of Land To have and to hold the said
 one hundred Acres of Land with all houses orchards Gardens fences: with all woods
 waters with privileges of fishing fowling and hunting with all profits Commodi-
 ty and Priviledges whatsoever thereunto belonging unto v: said Mary
 Bayly her heirs Executors Admrs: and Assignes: Against the Claim of v: the said
 Richard Ketton and Mary my wife: our heirs Executors Admrs or Assignes
 for ever: Warranting unto the said Mary Bayly her heirs and Assignes for
 ever quiet and peaceable possession of v: one hundred Acres of Land w:
 all the appertinances thereunto belonging: from the Claim trouble and
