 and calling to mind the uncertain State of this transitory life do make
 this my last will & Testament in manner & form as followeth First
 I bequeath my Soul to almighty God my Maker & to Jesus Christ
 my Redeemer & to the holy Ghost my Comforter and my body to the
 Earth from whence it came to be buried in such decent order as my
 Executors hereafter Nominated shall think fitt and as for my Temporal
 Estate w^{ch} I Lord hath been pleased far above my Deserts to bestow
 upon me I do order Give and bequeath & Dispose of it saune in manner
 and form as followeth Imprimis I Give unto my Son Edward Curtis
 one sett of Coopers Tools w^{ch} belonged to his father Item: I Give unto
 my Son Henry Curtis one feather bed & bouldster wth other appertaining
 pieces belonging unto it being known by y^e bed be lyath on & likewise
 two Cows & Calves & one Cattle Item: I Give unto my Son Joseph
 Curtis one feather bed & bouldster wth other appertinances belonging to
 it known by y^e bed in y^e outward Room up stairs and likewise y^e Green
 Chest in y^e outward Room below stairs Item: I Give unto my Son
 Revell Curtis one feather bed & bouldster wth best of y^e Covering in
 the house wth y^e Curtains & valances belonging to it known by y^e
 bed in y^e inner room up stairs and also one Goulde Ring & one silver por-
 inger and one silver Spoon and my still and one more or y^e still w^{ch} I
 came of the more I had of Francis Stokely likewise y^e still w^{ch} I
 came of all belonging to it y^e Chest up stairs y^e still before
 in case my Son Edward Curtis shall think fitt to have y^e still before
 named he paying his Brother Revell Curtis six pound Currant curreney of
 Virginia then my Son Edward may have y^e still Item: I Give unto my Daugh-
 ter Rachell Curtis one feather bed & bouldster wth other appertinances belong-
 ing to it known by y^e bed I lye on my self & also my horse called
 Hackly and my Riding saddle & a silver bodkin & her Kinning wheel
 Item: I Give unto my Daughter Jane Curtis one feather bed & bouldster
 wth other appertinances belonging to it known by y^e bed y^e Girls lyeth on
 also one mare called betty also her spinning spinin wheel Item: I Give
 to my Daughter Anne Curtis one feather bed and bouldster wth other
 appertinances belonging to it known by y^e bed in y^e low bedstead in y^e
 outward Room up stairs also one Gray mare I had of Hackly also her Kinning
 wheel & one small Chest of y^e small Cloths is in also one Table Clo-
 th & three Diaper napkins and other three napkins I Give to my Daugh-
 ter Jane and one Chest of y^e Girls Cloths is in Item: I Give unto my Son Revell
 my Bible Item: I Give to each of my Children w^{ch} hath had none given to
 y^e before to each of y^e one Bible namely y^e Children of now lives wth
 me Item: I Give to my Daughter Frances Springer one stilling Item: I Give
 to my Daughter Elizabeth Shields one stilling Item: I Give to my Daughter
 Sarah Watson one stilling Item: I Give to my Grand son John Springer
 one two year old heifer Item: I Give to my Grand son William Curtis one
 one yearling heifer Item: I Give to my Grand daughter Anne Watson one year-
 ling heifer Item: I Give to my Grand daughter Jane & Anne all my wooling wearing Cloths
 & Item: I Give to two daughters Jane & Anne all my wooling wearing Cloths

 of my personal Estate my will is y^e it shall be Equally divided betwixt my
 five Children namely Joseph Rachell Jane & Anne & Revell Curtis my debt
 being first paid & lastly I make Constitute & appoint my well beloved Son
 Edward Curtis & Thomas Springer jointly & severally Executors of this my
 last will & Testament Revoking all others as witness my hand & Seal
 the day & year above said
