

In the Name of God Amen y<sup>e</sup> 21 day of December 1717 I Richard Hill Ayres of  
County of Accomack being sick and weak in body but of good & sound memory giving witness  
to God for w<sup>t</sup> love and all other his blessings bestowed upon me and considering my  
estate of means left me therefor make & appoint this to be my last will and testa-  
ment in manner and forme following and first and former paille I do saye  
my love to God y<sup>t</sup> Great Creator of all things being Lord and truly merciful for all  
my sins hoping and truste believing through the merits and mediation of  
Jesus Christ my Redemer to receive a full and free pardon for them all and  
a place amongst the elect in endless happiness and my body to w<sup>t</sup> Earth from whence  
it was taken desiring a decent interment of it same at w<sup>t</sup> discretion of my  
wife & loving wife D<sup>r</sup> other Ayres whome I do hereby constitute and appoynt to be  
my full & whole executors and as for what worldshe estate w<sup>t</sup> Lord in his  
mercy has bestowed on me I do dispose of as followeth all my just debts being  
paid do give and bequeath to my wife my plantation where I now live  
for and during her natural life with all the profits thereof and at her  
decease do give & bequeath the plantation to gather with one  
hundred and fifty acres of land to my son Richd Ayres and his lawfull  
heires begotten of his body for ever it being the one halfe of a tract of  
land left me by my grandfather Richard Hill deceased I term I give to  
my son John Ayres w<sup>t</sup> other halfe of my tract of Land it containing three  
hundred acres to be equally divided between my two sons Richard & John  
Ayres & my will is that w<sup>t</sup> Land shall be divided beginning at w<sup>t</sup> corner  
tree that parts w<sup>t</sup> land between Hill Drummmond & I and from thence to w<sup>t</sup> br  
wch on w<sup>t</sup> south side of my tract of Land and if either of my two sons shoulde  
die in their manerhie or with out lawfull heires then there part to  
be in their manerhie or with out lawfull heires then there part to  
descend shall Rovest and fall to w<sup>t</sup> survivor I term I give to my wife  
D<sup>r</sup> other Ayres one choyse of my bed & bolster a ring and a pare of blankets & a pair  
of sheets and my will is w<sup>t</sup> at my wifes decease that the said Ring &  
blankets and sheets given her shall revert and fall to my daughter  
Mary Ayres I term I give to my son Richard Ayres one feather bed &  
bolster one ring & pare of blankets & a choyse of sheets and to my son Richd  
Ayres my new gun I term I give to my son John Ayres one feather  
bed & bolster one ring & a pare of blankets & a pare of sheets and my  
old gun I term I give to my daughter Francis Ayres one feather bed and  
bolster one Ring & a pare of blankets & pare of sheets I term I give to my  
daughter Ann Francis Ayres one feather bed and bolster one ring one pare  
of blankets and a pare of sheets and my will is w<sup>t</sup> what part of my  
estate not mentioned I give all & every part to my D<sup>r</sup> wife D<sup>r</sup> other Ayres  
during her widow wch but my will is that if my wife shoulde Marry  
again then what part of my estate that then of m<sup>t</sup> beng not men-  
tioned to be equally divided between my D<sup>r</sup> wife & children and my  
will is that if my son Richard Ayres shoulde have a mind to kee  
on that hundred & fifty acres of land deuided him he shall not be  
debarred nor hindered by my D<sup>r</sup> wife all which I do confirm with my  
hand & seal the day & year above said
