 being very sick and weak of body but of perfect sense and memory
 by that presents make this my last will and Testament as followeth
 I Give and bequeath my soul into D. hands of all mighty God that gave it
 and my body to D. Earth to Rich Christian like burial as I shall be thought
 fitting by my Executors after to be mentioned and as for my worldly estate
 I Give and bequeath as followeth; Item I Give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Elisabeth Jones that part of my plantation where on my dwelling house is
 and on the southerly side of the branch of Run know my plantation and
 much land as may contain to three hundred acres of land to her my daughter
 Elisabeth & her heirs lawfully begotten for ever & for want of such heirs to
 my daughter Licia Jones and and the heirs lawfully begotten of her body for
 ever and for want of such heirs to my Cousin William Savage and to D. heirs
 of his body lawfully begotten for ever and I want of such heirs to my Cousin
 Charles Savage and his heirs for ever; It I Give and bequeath unto my daugh-
 ter Licia Jones the other part of my plantation on the North side
 of D. afor^d Branch and the remaining part of my land being two hun-
 dred acres more or less to her my daughter Licia Jones and to D. heirs
 lawfully begotten of her body for ever & for want of such heirs to my daugh-
 ter Elisabeth Jones and to her heirs lawfully begotten for ever & for want
 of such heirs to my Cousin George Smith & to D. heirs of his body law-
 fully begotten for ever & for want of such heirs to my Cousin John Smith
 and his heirs for ever; It I Give my negro boy called Gole Equally between
 two daughter Elisabeth and Licia and that they may not sell their part
 except one to D. other when they come to Lawfull age and if either
 of my afor^d daughters die before they have sold to D. other that y^e
 the D. other to have D. negro boy and if both my afor^d daughters die
 and die without Lawfull heirs in that case my negro shall fall to
 Cousin according as my land is given; Item I Give and bequeath unto my
 daughter Elisabeth my shell an to the heirs lawfully of her body begotten
 for ever & for want of such heirs to fall to my daughter Licia and the heirs
 of her body and for want of such heirs to Cousin William Savage according
 as my land is given; It I Give unto my daughter Licia my hand Mill and
 to D. Lawfull heirs of her body & for want of such heirs to my daughter
 Elisabeth & D. Lawfull heirs of her body & for want of such heirs to my
 Cousin George Smith according as my land is given; It I Give and bequeath
 unto my daughter Elisabeth the best bed & furniture & one Iron pot
 her choice & frying pan three pewter dishes six plates & two puter Bafons &
 twenty y^d of stuff & my white mare & one Cow & one Gun & one piece
 of fine lining & my Cubbord one Tankard & one Chest; Item I Give & bequeath
 unto my daughter Licia one feather bed and furnitor wth best bed I have
 one Iron pot three puter dishes and six plates two Bafons one Tankard one
 gun one Horse called Duke one Cow & seven yard of stuff one piece of
 fine lining & one frying pan & one Chest; Item I Give all the Re-
 maining part of my estate after my debt & Legacies are paid to be
 equally divided between my three daughters I Give Elisabeth & Licia
 each of them appoint & make my two daughters Elisabeth Jones & Licia
 Jones sole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament Rouse
 my all other will or wills made by me att any time or times when I am
 in witness to D. promises I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
 fifteenth day of August in year of our Lord 1720
 Signed Sealed in presents of us it was order and before signed
