to my son Harry Leatherbury or to be begotten, and in case of his decease
without such issue then to my next heire of my the Testator.
And my will is that the remaining halfe part of one thousand acres of Land lying
and being in Accomack County in Woods opposite to Anancock Creek being five hundred
and fifti acres I leave to my Son Harry hereafter named to be sold at some reasonable time
after my decease for and towards the benefitt of my said Son Harry to improve him in
his Education and Learning, but if my sd Son dies before he cometh to age to receive
the benefitt of sd land as aforesaid, then I give the said land to my next heire
of me the Testator.

ecutrix of this my last will & Testament.
