In the Name of God Amen I Robert Savage being
 sick in body but in good sense & memory & for of better ordering of my
 Estate of God of his mercy bestowed on me I do order Letters Quire & bequeath
 same in manner & form following
 Imprimis I Give and bequeath to my Loving Son Jacob Savage my plantation house
 garden fences orchards ways & meadows & feeding Pastures being four hundred & thirty two
 acres of Land York by Left to me & my two Brothers as Thomas & John & william
 Savage by their Father Left to me by his Last will & Testament may more
 large make appear I Give & bequeath to my Son Jacob to him & his heirs lawfully
 begotten of his body & for want of such heirs to fall to his Brother Abells Savage
 to him & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body & for want of such heirs to my
 Brother William Savage this son Parker Savage & to his heirs for ever & if any
 said land & I Give to my Son Abells Savage & he should dye without heirs then
 to returne against my Son Jacob Savage & his heirs for ever then I Give & bequeath
 my Son Abells Savage Eighty seven Acres of Land I formerly bought of his
 Father John Savage to him & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body & for
 want of such heirs then to his Brother Jacob Savage & to his heirs lawfully
 begotten of his body & for want of such heirs then to Parker Savage & his
 heirs for ever - Then I Give & bequeath to my Son Jacob Savage all my
 Turness Tools & all my weavers Spindles of what kind soever & my Pistols &
 holsters & one Gun & two small Dishes & two putter plates & one small Iron
 Pott & one better Red & Golster and Perring to it. To be & one hand Mill &
 one great Miller & one sword & my best horse & bridle & saddle & all my
 Linnen & Cask to him & his heirs for ever then I Give & bequeath to my
 Son my Son Sarah Nelson one feather bed & Golster and white Covering
 belonging to it to her & her heirs for ever then I Give & bequeath to them
 that brings a key belonging to a Chest a bove shaves about 4 foot long & what
 in it they shall bring I Give a key belonging to it. To be & one hand Mill &
 what in it Left it be wth knife soever to it and their heirs for ever then
 I Give & bequeath to my God daughter Susanna Nelson one Linnen
 hand a good Rose and their Increase to her & to her heirs for ever then I
 Give & bequeath & bequeath unto Richard Savage Junr I. son of Sarah
 Warrenton one feather bed & Golster and Covering belonging to it and
 I desire if his mother Sarah Warrenton may keep it. To be & one hand Mill &
 in her possession till he comes to age & then to delivered to him & his
 heirs for ever then I Give to my Loving Brother William Savage my
 best Sule of Apperall to him & his heirs for ever then I Give to my
 Loving Friend John Henderson my mair to him and one Iron pst
 to him & his heirs for ever then my will & desire is that wth
 remaining parte of my Estate after my debts & funeral Charges
 are paid & Legacy. wth Remaining part of my Estate should be Equally
 Divided Between my Son Jacob & Abells & John Savage & Sarah Nelson &
 Susannah Joyner to be Equally Divided between them of what kind soever
 where it may be found then I Give & bequeath to them of what kind soever
 doe with my Estate to bring it to appraisement after my decess
 then my will and desire is yt my Son Jacob Savage and John
 Henderson both may stand to be my sole and whole Executors of this
 my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have; subscribed
 Reheunto Let my hand this 7th day of May Anno Dom 1720
