 Children of my Father Inherit y^e Kingdom prepared for you from

 y^e my loving wife Margaret Head dooing trip & John fittgarrod executor
 may give my poor body a decent burrell as they shall see fitting

I doe order that what power debt or debts I doe owe or may be justly proved
 may be fully satisfied & p^{er} 24 I give & bequeath to my three sons Robert
 Samuel Thomas Head & Charles Head, one hundred & fifty Acres of land being y^e
 on wth I now live upon to them & their heirs for ever

I Give to my loving wife Margaret Smead during her natural life and after her death
 to my now dwelling house & land together with five head of cattle & my own
 riding horse, & my saddle to her for it plantation life, or allots in her
 debt or due shall become due or accruing to me to take & receive to her
 own proper use & behoof. 4th I Give to my loving wife Margaret Smead
 during her life my mallatto bay named James but if it should happen
 she should dye then it Remains out of his time to come to my afore said son
 I Give & bequeath to my son John Smead my gun, sword & silver belt & cane
 to go along with my Pistol & houlsters & w. Rest of my personal Estate to be
 Equally divided amongst of Rest of my Children. 5th I Give bequeath to my
 son Robert Smead all my Coopers tools to his proper wife & behoof. But if he
 should be kept in Custody of my Decent John Fitzgerald till my son
 Robert attains to the age of fifteen years, & then to be delivered to him
 accordingly. And Lastly I doe make Ordain & appoint my loving
 wife Margaret Smead whole & sole executrix & my loving Brother Charles
 Smead & John Fitzgerald Executors of my will. I Stat to be adding & assisting
 to my Decent as they shall or may see fitting or convenient of the
 my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my

 part of my land from y^e gulle or Branche before mentioned to be
 Equally divided betwixt them I Give it to them & there Lawfull
 Aries Lawfull begotten of their bodies for Ever Seple I Give unto my
 son Honary Towles one Shilling sevenle I Give unto my son Stockton
 Towles one Shilling eightle I Give unto my loving wife all the Re-
 mainer part of my Estate of Rowshall Staff and all movables during her
 naturall life & after her decess I Give it to my son Thomas Towles
 Lastly I make my loving friends and neighbours Thomas Jenkinson & Thomas
 Jonkin son Juniors my two Executors of my Estate & to be my will full
 of this I doe I doe acknowledge as my Reelle Aett & deed & my last will
 & Testament as with my hand & seal the 17 day of January 1720
