

John I Give and bequeath unto my Son Robert and to his heirs for ever the other third part of my said land the marsh there unto belonging and adjoining only excepting part of my aforesaid Land at Matchipungo the marsh as aforesaid only excepting the land here before by me given to my son Richard to Run down to the Glades

John I Give and bequeath unto my Son John and to his heirs for ever the other third part of my aforesaid land at Matchipungo aforesaid Running down to the Land of Simon House Commonly called Novils Neck for his bounds

John I Give the aforesaid Marsh at Matchipungo to my three Sons viz. Richard, John and John and to their and every of their heirs respectively as aforesaid, only with restriction and Restriction that no one of them or their heirs as aforesaid shall put on or keep upon the said Marsh above Ten head of Cattel hogs or mares at one time without the mutual Consent and agreement of all the parties of their heirs as aforesaid.

John I Give and bequeath unto my Son John and to his heirs for ever the other third part of my personal Estate I do possess of of what Quality or Condition soever unto my Loving wife Mary during all the time she shall continue my widow or decedent as aforesaid all my personal Estate that is then remaining and properly belongs to her by me and bequeath to be equally divided between my Son Charles my Daughter Mary Roads the now wife of John Roads and Patience the now wife of John Leatt so that my said Children may have & receive an Equall share and proportion thereof

And I appoint and name my wife Mary to be my Sole Executrix hereby revoking and annulling all other wills and Testaments whatsoever by me formerly made Publishing and declaring this to be my last will & Testament in witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & that the day and year first therein mentioned
