1725 I the said Thomas Sinson of the County of Virginia being sick and weak
of perfect Sense and understanding thanks be to almighty God for it do hereby
make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form as
followeth I wish & principally I recommend my precious Soul into the hand
of my most merciful Creator & Redeemer which gave it me and my body
to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
I do give & bequeath unto my Son Thomas Sinson two hundred & Twenty Acres of Land
which I bought of Thomas Parker I do also give unto my said Son Thomas Sinson
fifty Acres of marsh more or less which I bought of Peter Gray well & Son
and I bequeath unto him & his heirs for ever also I give unto my Son Thomas
Sinson my Last gunn and a Case of pistols & a Bow & I do also
give unto him one feather bed with Virginia tick and 4 furniture belonging
unto it which he hath now in his possession
I give and bequeath two hundred Acres of Land unto my Son William Sinson
on which I bought of William Carter and also fifty Acres of Land
on which I now dwell with a fifty Acres I have marked by a line
I also give unto my Son William Sinson one hundred & thirty
Acres of marsh I give to my Son William Sinson one Case of pistols & a Bow
I also give to my Son William Sinson one hundred Acres of Land on which I now dwell
I give and bequeath two hundred Acres of Land on which I now dwell
I give to my Son John Sinson and also one hundred & twelve Acres of Land
with marsh more or less which I bought of Dr. and Allen I give of the Land & marsh
unto my Son John Sinson to him and his heirs for ever also I give
unto my Son John Sinson two feather beds & the furniture thereunto
belonging also I give to my Son John Sinson one gunn and a Case of
pistols and a Bow and three hundred and thirty one middle pot & also my hand mill
and one iron Pitt and one great and 1 horse that he calls his horse &
my dog called Spark and a pair of Band Irons also I give to my Son
John Sinson thirty head of cattle fifteen head of small kind & fifteen head
of female kind of choice of my stock Item I give to my Son John Sinson
one negro woman named Betty & one negro boy named Joe
I give to my daughter Sarah Sinson one negro woman named Jane
and one negro boy named Jacob and also two feather beds & the
furniture belonging to them and also fifteen head of cattle male and
female and my two biggest iron pots that is not already given and
also I give daughter Sarah four pewter dishes and three pewter basons
I give & bequeath to my Son William Sinson one negro man named Peter
I give to my Son Thomas Sinson one negro girl named Peter upon
promise he will pay to my Son John Sinson seven pounds current money
and if my Son Thomas refuse to pay it I will & desire is if
my daughter Elizabeth Bouty shall have the said negro girl Peter
I give to my daughter Sarah Sinson one brass Skillet
I give to my Son John Sinson one belmette Skillet and I give to my
daughter Sarah Sinson one gray mare also I give to the poor of this par-
ish one cow and pound of tobacco or five pound money which my Executors
please to pay I Item I give two Lively cows and calves to my wife
Sinson and for the rest of my personal Estate not herein mentioned
I do constitute appoint and Ordain my three Sons Thomas William
and John my lawful and sole Executors of this my last will & Testament
only in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my Seal the day and year above written

may not be inventoried nor appraised
The within last will & Testament of Thomas Sinson
