 istrator mentioned hereafter what wading State of Lord hath pleased to send me  
 in this the valle of my Pilgrimage to be disposed of as here after mentioned  
 by my Executors

I give and bequeth unto my Son Joseph Robbins of Plantation wharone my  
 father John Robbins Leav one wch fall to me by Inheritance as it contains  
 two hundred Acres of Land itt Lying & being in Ansonack County to him  
 and his heirs for ever, Item I give and bequeth unto my three daughters  
 viz Dianah Robbins Sarah Robbins ann Stirling Robbins one half for appor-  
 of yt age of three years old to be payde them when they come to yt age of age  
 fifteen or marry - Item I give and bequeth unto my daughter Elizabeth  
 Robbins five sheep five ewes & a Ram & six Plates of puter one large puter  
 dish to be payde her when she come to yt age of age of eighteen or married  
 I give and bequeth unto my Son John Robbins my Largest Iron pott and a  
 horse a bout three years old to be payde him at my State when he come to  
 yt age of age of eighteen - Item It is my will & desire yt my two Sons John  
 Robbins and Joseph Robbins shall be sett att Liberty wher they come to yt  
 age of age of eighteen years to be att their own disposing to take into there  
 what I have mentioned in this my Last will & Testament  
 It is my will and desire yt my two friends William Williamson and  
 Thomas Townsend shd to be trusted to take their best care in yt whilft  
 of my Son Joseph Robbins to look after his Plantation wch I have given  
 him and it is my will and desire yt my Son Joseph shall not sell  
 his Land to any person withoutt yt free Consent of these my two friends  
 while he comes to yt age of five and twenty  
 I give unto my Loving wife Sarah Robbins all yt Rente of my Estate not  
 already given and Lastly I doe Ordain constitute and appoint my Loving  
 wife Sarah Robbins my heir & sole executrix of this my Last will  
 and Testaments Resolving & disavowing all other will or wills made  
 to for made or caused to be made by me in Wittness wher of I have  
 here set my hand and fixed my seale this 27 day of Moner ber  
 seventeen hundred and Eighteen
