Item. I give to my loving Wife Mary the plantation whereon I live with all appurtenances thereto belonging & all the Adjacent land thereto belonging being one hundred & fifteen Acres more or less during her naturall life & I hereby request my said wife to permit her daughter Rhoda to

decently interr'd at the discretion of my Executrix hereafter named. Item I give to

my loving Wife Mary the plantation whereon I live with all appurtenances thereto belonging

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& all the adjacent land thereto belonging being one hundred & fifteen Acres more or less

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during her naturall life & I hereby request my said wife to permit her daughter Rhoda to live in one of the houses upon my said plantation which my said wife pleases & also to give her the privilege of Sowing yearly a peck of flax Seed & raising fowl & such other necessary priviledge as my said wife shall see proper & requisite & these priviledges to continue to her no longer then during my said wifes pleasure & after my said wifes death I give the s^d Land & plantation to the Eldest daughter of the said Rhoda the wife of William Chence & the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever & for want of such to Mary Daniel the daughter of William Daniel & Mary his wife & her heirs for ever & if the said Eldest daughter of the said Rhoda who is now unbaptiz'd & who I desire may be named Margerett should be under the Age of twenty one years or unmarried at my said Wifes death I appoint her mother the said Rhoda if she shall at that time be a widow or her present husband dead & not otherwise to receive the profitts of the same till her said daughter comes to full Age or marries wthout account for the same but if the said Chence be then alive I appoint & will that William Daniel & Mary his wife or the Survivour of them receive the profitts of the same

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for the use of the said daughter of the said Rhoda & Expend the same for her necessary Education & maintenance till she shall be of full age or marry which first shall happen. appoint my said wife Mary Executrix of this my last will & Testament & desire that she may
not be compell'd to give any Security for my Estate & I hereby revoke & disannul all former
wills by me heretofore made all which I Confirm with my hand & Seal this 21st day of March
1733
