natural lives & they on consideration hereof are to contribute to the keeping the said
tools in good order & fit for use & service Item I give to Eastland Rogers daughter of
Jacob Rogers a feather bed Item all the rest of my estate to be equally divided between
my sister Eleanor Nickless aforesaid & my aforesaid brother Jonathan Rowles. Item I
constitute nominate & appoint my brother in law Cap^t Hancock Nickless & my aforesaid
Brother Jonathan Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me heretofore made all which I confirm with my hand & seal this tenth day of
