hundred and Seventeen acres of Land & marsh lying on Indian River binding on the Land  
of Hugh Tingle at Rumbly marsh During their natural Lives and after their decease I  
give the same to my Grandson Mathew Rogers to him and his heirs lawfully begotten for-  
ever Item I give and bequesth to my Son Philip Parker three head of Cattle and one  
mare to pay to my Grandson Mathew Rogers when he shall attain to the age of Eighteen  
years Item I give to my Grandson Mathew Rogers one feather bed and bolster a pair of  
blanketts one Sheet and three Chairs, three pewter Dishes and Six Plates Item I give  
and bequesth to my Daughter Winney, Rogers all my weering Cloaths Excepting one Striped  
Silk Stuff Sute - one Apron I give to Mary Budd & Caps as also to my Daughter Winney  
I give my Side Saddle and I do make and appoint my son in Law Sollomon Rogers my sole  
Executor of this my Last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set  
my hand and Seal This 25 day of January 1729.
