by my Execut<sup>s</sup> hereafter mentioned & as to my worldly Estate doe give & bequeath it as  
followeth (Vizt) Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife the one half of this  
plantetion whereon I now live & half of all the Improvements thereon w<sup>t</sup> half the orchard  
& half the use of the Still & also half of all the Marsh down the Neck & all the Stock  
Except what's hereafter given & also all my Negroes during her Widowhood to bring up

the Children & to Educate them & also to pay w<sup>t</sup> debts I owe in right to any one but if my  
wife should Marry then she to have but one third of my Estate before mentioned & the  
remainder to be Equally divided between my Children Vizt Ann Sarah Prissilla, Betty,  
Levin, Jn<sup>o</sup>, Charles & Clement I also give unto my wife all the household Goods as aforesaid  
& if she Marry then to be divided among the Children aforesaid in manner & form as aforesaid

remainder to be Equally divided

& if she <sup>29th</sup> die before me then to be divided among the Children aforesaid in manner & form as aforesaid

2d I give to my Son Geo after his mothers decease all my Lands & Marsh whereon I now live  
Except four hundred Acres where Mr Wets now lives on beginning at the head of back Creek  
so running up as the neck Fence now runs so as Cross from the neck fence to the head line  
to include four hundred Acres wch I to my Son John & his heirs and if my Son Geo should  
Dye without Lawfull Issue then the land given to him to be Equally divided between John  
Charles & Clement my three Sons. I also give my Son Geo. three Cows and Calves & ten  
head of Sheep & half the<sup>3d</sup> still as long as his Mother lives & after her deceasse the  
whole still I give and bequeath unto my Son Thos<sup>3d</sup> and his heirs for Ever three hundred  
Acres of Land on Pocomoke three Cows & Calves & ten head of sheep 4th I give and  
bequeath to my Son Levin & his heirs one hundred & fowty Acres of Land on Pokomoke being  
part of the same tract I gave his bro<sup>r</sup> Thomas. I give my Son John Liberty to keep  
twenty head of Cattle in the Neck. 5th I give to my daught<sup>r</sup> Ann after her Mothers  
deceasse or after she Marry's my Negro Boy Joe. 6th I give to my daugh<sup>r</sup> Sarah after her  
mothers deceasse or after her marriage my Negro Girl Rachel. 7th I give unto my daugh<sup>r</sup>  
Priscilla after as aboves<sup>d</sup> my Negro Boy Called Ben 8th I give to Betty the first  
Child thts born of the Negroe Woman Called Sarah 9th And if the above Negroe women should  
have any more Children after that should live I give one to Charles & another to Clement.  
10th After my wifes decease I give my Negroe Peter to my son Charles and my Negroe Sarah  
to my Son Clement Lastly I appoint my loving Wife & my son Geo and Mr Geo. DASHAWLE  
Execut<sup>s</sup> to this my last will & Testament revoking by these presents all others by me made  
heretofore & doe Declare this and no other Witness my hand & Seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day 7<sup>br</sup>
