manner and form as followeth First I bequeeth my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my
maker hoping that through the meritorious Death and passion of my Lord & Saviour Jesus
Christ to Receive free pardon of all my Sins and as for my body to be buried at the dis-
cretion of my Executor.

Item I Give and bequeeth to my two Sons Liddleton Armitrader and William Armitrader three
hundred Acres of Land which I bought of John Morris to them and their heirs to be Equally
Divided between them I also Give to my Son Henry Armitrader the Land & plantation that I
bought of Robert Taylor to him and his heirs and also my right and title I have to that
Mill Dam joining to Jacob Chances Land that to him and his heirs.

Item I Give and bequeeth to my Son Richard Armitrader the plantation whereon I now
Live with all the Land belonging thereunto to him and his heirs and also a piece of Land
Joyning to Jonathan Garissons Land on the one Side and Edward Kellams on the other Side
Containing Sixty Acres more or Less to him & his heirs and also I Give to my Son Richard
Armitrader all my Lands in Northampton County to him and his heirs I Give to Each of my
three Sons namely Richard Armitrader John Armitrader and William Armitrader one feather
bed a piece and furniture Such as is to them & be made as Equall in Goodness as they Can
I Give my Daughter Roxe Willis one two Year old heifer with a white face I Give to my
Son John Armitrader one Small Iron pott & hooks that's to it one Breeding Sow I Give to
my Son William Armitrader my Riding horse Saddle and Bridle one Cow and Calf one old Broken
Iron pott and one Small Iron Kittle I Give and bequeeth to my Son Arthur Armitrader one
Shilling in Cash I Give to my Son Liddleton Armitrader four Sheep & my Son John Armitrader

Shilling in Cash I Give to my Son Lidleton Armitrader four Sheep & my Son John Armitrader
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two Sheep I Give all my pewter to be Divided Equally amongst all my Children Excepting
my Son Arthur Armitrader.

Item I Give and bequesth all the remainer of my Estate to my Son Richard Armitrader.
I do make Constitute & appoint my Son Richard Armitrader Sole Executor of this my last
will and Testament Revoking all other wills & Testaments whatsoever as Witness my hand
