In the name of God Amen this eighteenth day of July and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred thirty and Seven I James Aymes Planter of the County of Accomack in Virginia being Sick & weak of body but of perfect Sense and memory praised be God for the Same do by these presents make this my last Will and Testament Imprimis I give and bequesth my Soul in the hands of Almighty God that gave it me hoping through his mercies and the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have pardon of all my Sins & my body to the Earth from Whence it was taken to Such Christian like buriall as Shall be thought fitting by my Executor after to be named & as for my worldly Estate after my debts and funerall Charges are paid I give and bequesth as followeth (Viz^t) I give unto my Daughter Esther my best bed & furniture & two pewter Dishes and Six pewter plates & three porringers and one Bason and one quart pott & two Tankards and two Heifers and one ew Lamb and one Iron pot a large one and one large Chest and one large Table item I give and bequesth unto my Wife my horse and one Couch and one hand Mill Item I give and bequesth unto my Brother William Aymes my Spoon moulds and all that belongs to them item I give and bequesth all the remaining part of my Estate to be Equally Divided between my Wife Mary and my Daughter Esther And Lastly I nominate and appoint and make my Brother William Aymes the whole Sole Executors of this last Will and Testament Revoking all other will or Wills made by me at any time or times whensoever do Declare and publish this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness I have hereunto Set my hand Seal the day and Year
