A Division of the Land given by John Bonnewell deceased to his two Sons James & John Bonnewell as followeth Beginning at a marked Pine standing in the old Field near the divisional Line between William Wise & the said Bonnewells & running about an East or East by North Course by a Line of marked Trees to a red Oak standing near the Road leading down Onancock Creek thence running about North East by a Line of marked Trees to the Head Line between Them & John Sneed and all the Land lying to the Eastward & Southward of the said Line to be the part of James Bonnewell & all the remainder to be the part of John Bonnewell. The Condition of this obligation is such that whereas John Bonnewell decd in last did his Will bequesth to his two Sons James & John Bonnewell his plantation with all his Lands thereto belonging to be divided between them by a line of marked Trees to be afterwards made between them which Line has been since made to wit on the fifteenth Day of February 1735 In presence of John Smith & Joachim Michael Bonnewell Now if the above bounded John Bonnewell & his Heirs &c^d shall abide by & stand to the Division afd & not interrupt nor disturb the said James Bonnewell or his Heirs &c^d in the peaceable possession of his part of the afd Land & premises That then the above Obligation to be void & of no Effect or otherways to stand Remain & be in full Force & Virtue.
