 Divers good causes and considerations and more Especially for the natural Love and
 affection I bear to my brother Sam^l Wise do give & grant unto him my said Brother Samuel
 Wise all my right title & Interest of and in a Certain Island lying and being in the
 County aforesaid Called & Known by the name of Foxes Island together with all rights &
 priviledges Marshes Woods underwoods Waters and water Courses and all the appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him my aforesaid brother Samuel Wise
 and his heirs or Assigns forever And I the said John Wise do for myself my heirs Ex^{rs}
 & Adm^{rs} warrant & defend the said Island from any person or persons Claiming any right
 or title to the said Island for by or under me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set
 my hand & affixed my Seal this Sixth Day of August Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hund^d
 and twenty nine.
