This Indenture made this Second day of November Anno Dom^o Seventeen hundred thirty and Six Between Peter Marshall of Accomack County of the one part and William Marshall of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Peter Marshall for and in Consideration of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco to him the said Peter Marshall in hand paid at or before the Ensigning and delivery hereof by the said William Marshall the Receipt whereof the said Peter hereby doth acknowledge hath granted bargained & Sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and Sell to the said William Marshall his heirs and Assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcell land lying and being in Jingoague Neck in the County afores^d containing by estimation twenty Acres be the Same more or less and is bounded as follows beginning at Charles Marshall Southwest corner tree upon Kendall Towles line being a mark'd Hickory thence alonge the said Charles's head or west line to a mark'd Dogwood upon Welbourn or Wards line thence westerly along the said Welbourn & Wards line
