In the Name of God Amen I John Hutchinson of Accomack County in Virginia being in Sick & Low Condition but of sound Mind Memory & Understanding thanks beto God therefore do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner " form following First I bequeeth my Soul & Body into the hands of Almighty God that by the blessed oblation of my Saviour the one at the time of my Dissolution the other at the time of my Resurrection & for Such Worldly Goods as the Goodness of God has bestowed on me I give & bequeeth the Same in

manner as followeth Item I give to my Son John Hutchinson my Chest & all things in the said Chest I also give to my said Son John all my Carpenters Tools I also give to my said Son John my Gun I also give to my Said Son John all my socks Item I give to John Pratt my Gray Mare that I bought of him to him his heirs or Assigns Item I give to my well beloved Wife Klizabeth after my Just debts paid the use of all my Estate which is not before by no other

to be equally divided amongst my Children John Marshaba Anne Rachel Betty & Tabey & of
this my Last Will & Testament I do Constitute & appoint my wife Klizabeth my Executrix
& my Son John my Executor In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this
tenth day of November 1735/ Sign'd Seal'd published & declared by me John Hutchinson to
be my Last Will & Testament
