I John Solsbery of the County of Accomack in Virginia being weak and Impotent of Body but of Sound & Perfect Memory praise be given to God for it and takeing into Consideration The uncertainty of Mens Life heere & That all Men are borne to die once Do therefore Make Nominate Constitut & a point this My Last will and Testament In Manner and form as followeth first and princibbly I bequesth my soul to the hands of almighty God that Gave it me hoping Through the Merits and Mediation of Jesus Christ to obtain free pardon for all my sins & a fencis & My Body to the grave to Be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executrix heere after Named & as Touching the Disposiell of Such worldly goods as the Lord hath bin pleased to Besto on me as followeth

Item I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah Solsbery Three Cows with their Incress, & one Goon & one Iron Framell one Dish & three plates 1/2 a Dozen of Spoons and one Feather bed too blankets boulder and pillow To her and her Disposing.

Item I give and Bequesth to my above s^d wife all the Remaining part of my Estate During her Natural Life & what Remains at her Deeth to be Equally Devided Between My Two Children W^m Solsbery & Mary Solsbery. I also Nominate Corstetut & a point My Loving above s^d
