Seventeen hundred & Thirty I Richard Cutler of the County of Accomack Wesver being in health & perfect Memory thanks be given unto God for it Calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body Do make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testam^t that is to Set ffirst I Give & Bequeath my Soul to God that gave it & my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like Manner at the Discretion of my Execu^{rs} & touching Such Worldly Estate as it hath Pleased God to bless me in this Life I Give & Bequeath in the ffollowing fform & Manner Imprimis I Give & Bequeath unto my two Sons George & Willism Cutler & their Heirs for Ever After my Decease the Plantation I now live on Containing three hundred acres of Land to be Equelly Divided Between them Always Provided & it is my Will that my Son George & his Heirs for Ever shall have the Mammor Plantation Whereon I now Live & So much of the Land next adjacent thereto as shall make up One hundred & ffifty Acres of Land I also Give & Bequeath to my Son George Cutler one Loom three Sets of Slays & Geers & what I have fformerly Given I Confirm unto him Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Son Richard Cutler & his heirs for Ever One hundred & ffifty acres of Land in the fforked Beck that I bought of Charles Leatherbury & also one ffleather bed & ffurniture one large Chest one Iron Pot one Bell Mettle Skillett I also give unto my Son Richard One Pair of Cullen Mill Stones with my other Loom & all the Rest of my Geers & Slays Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Son John Cutler & his Heirs for Ever One hundred Acres of Land w^{ch} I bought of W^m Lewis wth my Lot of Land & House in the Town of Crancock I also give unto my Son John one ffleather Bed & ffurniture one Chest one large Cupboard one Iron Pot Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Son W^m Cutler besides the Land before given One ffleather Bed & ffurniture One Pair of Cullen Mill Stones one Chest One Iron Pot & a large brass Kettle Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Roberts one Silver Spoon Item I further Give & Bequeath unto my

Bequeath unto my Son W^m Cutler besides the Land before given One feather Bed & ffurniture
One Pair of Cullen Mill Stones one Chest One Iron Pot & a large brass Kettle Item I
Give to my Daughter Mary Roberts one Silver Spoon Item I ffurther Give & Bequeath unto my
Grandaughter Sneed one feather Bed & what ffurniture can be Spar'd one Small black Trunk
& one Iron Pot Item I Give & Bequeath what Sheep & Cattle I have unto my ffive Children
that is to say Mary George Richard John & William it is also my Will that my three Sons
Richard John & William have their Priviledge of Living here with their Parts of the
Orchard & Pasture During their Pleeasure Provided they Do not Marry also my Negroe Woman
Bess to Live among them while they Continue together & also it is my Will that if they
Marry or Separate the S^d Negroe Woman Shall be my Daughter Mary Roberts & her heirs I
Do give the Use of my Still unto all my Children that will come to it with their own
Proper Effects & not Others & ffurthermore I Give the Rest of my Personall Estate to be
Equally Divided between my three Sons Richard John & W^m Cutler Excepting one old large
brass kettle One Silver Spoon to my Son George & also one Silver Spoon to Each of my
three Sons Richard John & William this is my Will also that no Part of my Estate Shall
Come to an appreisment Lastly I appoint my Sons Richard & John Execu^{rs} of this my
Last Will & Testament & ffurthermore this my Last Will Dissallowing & Revoking all other
fformer Wills In Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand & Seal the Day & Year above
Written.
