Item all the residue of my Estate real & personal I Give to my loving wife afs^d her Heirs & Assigns for ever to whom I also devise the sole tuition of all my Daughters. Item I constitute nominate & appoint my loving wife afs^d Cap^t Hancock Hickless Mr George Douglas Scerburgh Tunnell & James Wiahart executors of this my last will & Testam^t & Devise to Them the Tuition of all my Sons & Hereby impower my said Executors out of the

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profits of their Estates to educate Them as They Shall think proper or to bind Them or any of them out in such manner as they or the major part of them accepting the Executorship shall think proper.
