The Condition of this Obligation is Such that Whereas the Afores^d William Arbuckle & John Wise are bound to the Justices of Accomack for the Estate of John West Dec^d Now if the Af^d Nathaniel Holland Sacker Parker & George Parker Do keep the Af^s John Wise & William Arbuckle harmless & ffree ffrom all Trouble Costs or Charges that they might or may have from the time of giving bond afores^d & for Ever after the Date of these Presents then this Obligation to be Void Null & of no Effect or Else to Stand in ffull fforce & Virtue
