ing. Imp<sup>re</sup> I give and bequesth my Soul to the Almighty God who gave it trusting that  
through the meritts of my redeemer Jesus Christ I shall obtain eternall Salvation. And  
my body I Leave to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors herein after  
mentioned. And as for my Estate reel and personall I dispose thereof as followeth Item  
I give to my beloved wife Mary Barton my Sorrel Horse & Saddle and my will is that Jack,  
Thom, Monday and Frank do remein on the Plantation to do any Service or Labour my wife  
shell Employ them in during her naturall Life and my meaning is that they shall be at  
her command during her Natural Life as if I had really given her, and if she accepts  
of the Service of these Negroes it shall barr her of her Thirds in any of the other  
Negroes I also give her a Feild of Corn Lying on the main road I also give her a heavy  
hoghead of Tobecco I also give her what beef is killed in the house. Item I give and  
bequesth to my two Daughters in Law Anne Sneed and Catherine Sneed two Shares of my  
Crop made when Spencer Johnson was overseer here and likewise, I give them four weeding  
hoes. Item I give and bequesth my Slaves Peter with Peg and her two Children called  
ergol and Marie to the use of Daughter Agnis during her natural Life and at her death  
to be equally divided smongst her Children. Item I give and bequesth to my Son William  
and to the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten the Land & Negroes following Viz<sup>t</sup> Two  
hundred and fifty acres of Land and Marsh I bought of William Clark Lying upon Pothooks  
Creek Near Lewis Town with Bester, Ben, Leeh, Daniel and Comfort I also give to my said  
Son my new Saddle new boots & Silver Tankard Likewise my pistols holsters & Sword.  
Item I give to my Nephew Thomas Burton a yearling mare and to my three Nephews Joshua  
Samuel & Joseph to each of them I give a Mare Colt Item I give to my two Nephews Caleb &

Creek Near Lewis Town with Easter, Ben, Leah, Daniel and Comfort I also give to my said Son my new Saddle new boots & Silver Tankard Likewise my pistols holsters & Sword. Item I give to my Nephew Thomas Burton a yearling mare and to my three Nephews Joshua Samuel & Joseph to each of them I give a Mare Colt Item I give to my two Nephews Caleb & Abner Burtons my bay mare called Rose Item I give to my Grandson John West a yearling mare that come of my old Dun mare Item I give & bequeath at the Death of my wife to my William my Slave Frank and my Slaves Jack Thom & Monday to the Children of my Daughter Agnis already born and to be born And as for the rest of my Estate of what kind soever after my just Debts are paid I give to be equally divided Between my wife and two Children and I do hereby make and Constitute my wife and two Children my Executors and Lastly I do hereby revoke all other wills and Testam<sup>t</sup> by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my & Seal this Eighteenth day of November 1730
