being sick and weak of Body but of a sound Memory do make this my Last Will and Testament  
Impromiser. I give and bequeath my Soul to Almighty God which Gave it, as to my Body  
I leave to be Buried in a decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter  
mentioned. As to my worldly Estate I give and bequeath in Manner as followeth.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Lucy Spencer four Hundred acres of Land  
Lying in Bedford County during her Natural Life & after her Death to be Equally  
Divided between my three Sons, Griffith, Abraham & John Spencer, the John is not  
Baptized; Item I leave to my said Wife all the Negroes which it hath bin Pleased  
God to bestow on me with in Halifax County also the Negroes in Hanover County during  
her natural Life and afterwards to be Equally Divided between my Children, that is  
to say, Griffith, Abraham, John, Susannah & Lucy Spencer.

Item my Will is that part of my Estate should be sold of which shall be sufficient to pay  
my Lawful Debt, and no more.

Item I do hereby appoint my Brother John Spencer of Albemarle County my whole &  
sole Executor of this my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby revoke all other Wills & bequeath  
by me heretofore made. In Witnes Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this  
22<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1741.
