In the Name of God Amen, I David Mills of Albemarle County
do make this my last Will & Testament. In witness I appoint my Dear
Wife Lucy Mills Executrix and my particular Frds Isaac Davis & Wm Barked.
together with my son Lachariah Mills, the Survivor or Survivors of them two
of this my last Will & Testament. Item, I give & bequeath unto my Executrix
& their Heirs for ever, all my Lands, (excepting such part thereof as is herein
after particularly devised) together with all & every the Sum & Sums of Money
& whatever else shall be due to me from any person or persons at my Death
for the Following uses & purposes: that is to say to the Intent that they the
Survivors or Survivor of them his Executrix or Administrators (as soon as convenient)
may be after my Death I shall sell the said Lands & lay out the Money
thence arising, together with the Money & whatever else shall be due to me after
paying all my Debts & Funeral charges in purchasing young Female Slaves
which they are to divide equally among my Children or their Representatives.
Item, Whereas I have a large Survey of land on buck Mountain Creek my
Will & desire is that my Executrix do (in a short time after my Death) devise
it in the Following Manner: to wit beginning on Buckmountain Creek
and continuing up the same according to lines of the first Survey to the
Musterfield path nigh John Davis from thence round the Fence to the Mouth
of Little Creek from thence to the highest part of the Back line. From thence
down the said line and round on the lines of the first Survey to the Beginning
all the lands in which Survey (excepting such part thereof as is herein after
devised to my Executrix for the use of my beloved Wife Lucy & her heirs
to my Son Lachariah Mills & his Heirs for ever. Item I give & Devise to my
Executors four hundred acres of Land above the Road which shall
Include my Dwelling House & be included in the above Survey for my son
Lach. Mills with this before provided with this special Trust I beseeche

to ent that they the Survivors or Survivor of them his last or Administrator
Suffer my beloved Wif Lucy Mills to have & Occupy the said Land &
dwelling House to her own Special Use & behoof during her Widownhood & till her
Death if she shall never Marry again: & then to ent at her Marriage or Death
as the case shall be, I give & Devise the said Land & Dwelling House to my son
Zachariah Mills & his Heirs for ever. Item I give & Devise to my son David
Mills & his Heirs for ever all the Residue of my Duck Mountain Creek Survey
Item I give & Devise unto my Son Zyal Mills & his Heirs for ever all my
Deaverdam Swamp Tract of Land. Item I give & Devise to my son Joseph
Mills, & his Heirs for ever a thousand Acres of Land adjoining Bear Creek. Item
I give & Devise to my Sons Zachariah Mills & to their Heirs for ever all the part
Survey & Courses Survey & my Will & Desire is, that my Executors divide the said
Tracts into Two parts, equal with Respect to Quantity: & that David have that
part adjoining Thomas Ballards line & back, the other: Item I give & Devise
to my sons Zachariah Mills, David Mills, Zyal Mills, & Joseph Mills & their
Heirs forever, all that Tract of Land lying on the Great Mountains which I
bought of David Thomson, & my Will & desire is that my Executors in
short time after my Death divide the said Lands into four parts equal each
with respect to Quantity & Quality, & Design to each of my sons a Specified
part, Item I give & Devise to my Daughters Anna Mills & Elizabeth Mills &
their Heirs forever the eight Hundred Acres of Land which was in the posse-
sion of James Beaton, & my Will & desire is that my Executors in a short
time after my Death divide the said Land into two parts equal with respect
to Quantity & Quality & that Anna have that part which shall include
the garden Spot I Elisabeth that which joins Gardicks line Item I give
& Devise to my Daughters Mary Mills & Lucy Mills & their Heirs forever
Eight Hundred Acres of Land which shall adjoin Turpman, & my Will & desire
is that my Executors do in a short time after my Death Survey the said Land
in such a Manner that it shall extend from Turpmans to the Line below
Fishing Back: & then divide it into Two parts equal with respect to Quality
& Quantity and that Mary have that adjoining Turpman & Lucy that adjoin-
ing the Line below fishing back, Provided nevertheless it is my Will &
Desire that if my children die without issue of his her or their body

or Bodies begotten, that then the Devotion or Devisions be so as herein after mentioned & for the uses & purposes herein after particularly named, from I give & Devise to my Executors, the Survivor or Survivor of them or his Executors or Administrators & their Heirs for ever all & every the Devotion or Devisions of Land which shall be in consequence of the death of any of my children, with this Express promise & with this Special Trust & Confidence, that is to say to the intent that they may sell of the same & Divide the Money thence arising among my children or their Representatives equally item I give & Devise to my Executors Will, Jammy, Rachael & Sarah with her Children together with all my Household Furniture, with this Express promise & with this Special Trust & Confidence, to wit, that they suffer my beloved wife Lucy Mills to have & occupy the same & every of them to her own special use & behoof during her Widowhood till her death ipsoe never Marry again; and then to wit at her Marriage or Death as the case shall be, I give & bequeath the same & every of them to my children or their Representatives, item I give & bequeath all the residue of my Estate not herein already mentioned particularly to my children or their Representatives to be equally divided among them by my Executors this is my last Will & Testament signed with my hand & sealed with my seal dated this Twenty eighth Day of February one thousand seven hundred & forty four
