will In the name of god Amen, I Henry Wood of the parish of St. Andrew the Lanrty of Allimant, being weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory Thanks be given god, therefore do make this my Last will & Testament Purshing & disallowing all wills by me heretofore made, but an Principally I Recommend my Soul to god that gave it, & my Body to be Intred, in such a decent manner, as my Executors hereafter named Shall think fit, and as Touching the Temporal Estate it hath pleased god to Endow me with, after my Just debts & Charges are payed, I give & Bequeath as following, Item now I give to my Son Richard Wood, my plantation whereon I now Live containing 110 Acres with all my Stock & household furniture, and his to maintain me & my wife ~~Agulah~~ Wood and my son Thomas saudage Wood, during my Life & theirs, Suptly & do constitute & Appoint my son Richard Wood my whole and Soul & Executor of this my Last will & Testament Aswitness my hand & Seal this 1st Day of December Anno Domini 1772
