Yearling Shall be Given to her Item I send to Mary Cant my
Well belov'd Wife all & Singular all Other the Goods & Chattels as
I am possessed with during her Natural life or widowhood
& then to be Equally Divided between my two Daughters Margaret
Marr & Isabel McDonnel Item I Give & bequeath to Howard Cash
& John Marr five Shillings to be levied out of my Estate whom I
Appoint & constittute Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
working & Annulling by these Testaments both & Every Testament &
Testamantis Will & Wills hant forsw by me made declared either by
Word or Writing & this & no other to taken as my Last Will & Testament
