In the name of god Amen I Jull Twissell of the parish of Fredericksville in the County of Allentown being of perfect mind & Memory thanks be given to god, therefore do make & Ordain this my Last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all, I give & Bequeath my Soul to god who gave it, My Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, and as for my worldly goods I dispose of the same in the following manner To wit
Item my will & desire is that my Executors do sell the two lots and Improvements I own in the Town of Charlottenville with the Improvements thereon, if they think it most proper also to sell two out lots 1004 containing 73 Acres the other is 1014 containing 51 Acres also one Tract Laying on Hughes Road, Joying Gentry & Haggards Land containing 107 Acres, also 24 Acres Joining the Land of John Henry Carter, and he to have a Deed for the same, 1703 or paying Money provided for it also to sell & Dispose of one Tract of Land in Louisa containing 252 Acres and make Deeds for the same.

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Adams what I have delivered to her which will appear by my book with two negroes Judah and Hannah

Hammer and then I care to her & her heirs for ever
 Item I give to any of my Children as they Come of Age or marries as
 for ever — I send to my wife Anna all my Estate to be under the
 direction of my Executors till my Son Richmond Comes of age only
 as any Child of age or marries to be made Equal with my daughter
 Mary. If my wife should not marry for the Support of her and my
 Children I wish my Son Richman Comes of age then my personal
 Estate to be divided Among my Children after that made Equal with
 my Daughter Mary that is all my Children & wife to have an Equal
 part of my personal Estate after my wife's Death the part I send her to be
 divided Among all my Children that then living or there which be
 they & their heirs for ever —

Item I give to my Son Richman & Joell Terrell whereon I now live
 to them & their heirs for ever.

Item I give to Mary Terrell Joyner if she is alive Ten Pounds

Item I give to Peter Joyner Ten Pounds if he is alive

Item I do hereby Ordain, Constitute & Appoint David Thomas Walker
 my Son Terrell, James Kerr to be my whole & sole Executors of this my
 Last will & Testament, and I do hereby disallow, Revoke and disannul
 all former wills by me made at any time. Ratifying & confirming
 this and no other to be my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this twentieth & Ninth
 day of July One Thousand Seven hundred & Seventy three
