 Cox half the Tract of Land whereon I now live with the Manner
 Plantation also One Negro Boy Named Matt and One Negro Girl Named
 Aggy also One Negro Boy Named Wat to him & his Heirs & assigns for
 ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son Edward Cox the
 other half of my Tract of Land that I now live on also Three Negro Boys
 Named Sack Lewis Cain to him his Heirs & assigns for ever. Item I give
 & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Cox Two Negro Boys Named
 Isaac & Sam & also One Negro Girl Named Will to her & her Heirs & assigns
 for ever. Item my Will is that my Stock of Cattle Hogs Hens & Sheep be
 Equally Divided amongst my Three Sons & my youngest Daughter Elizabeth
 to them their Heirs & assigns for ever. Item I give unto my beloved Daughter
 Sarah Ward Five Shillings Sterling to her & her Heirs & assigns for ever.
 Item my Will is that my Son William Cox have all my Estate that I
 have not already gave away but my Three Beds which I desire may be
 divided between my youngest Children Edward Benjamin & Elizabeth to
 them their Heirs & assigns for ever. Item my Will is that all my Estate be
 kept together til all my Just Dotts & funeral Charges be paid. Lastly I do
 appoint my Son William Cox and my Friend Thomas Tophing Mica
 Thomas my Heir & Sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking all former Wills by me made Declaring this & only this
 to be my last Will & Testament in Testimony of which I have hereunto
 set my hand & Seal Affixed my Seal this 5th Day of April 1762.
