In the Name of God Amen I John Cox of Allendale County being in
sound Mind & memory thank be to God for the same but Considering the
Inevitability of this life & the Certainty of Death do make & ordain this my
last Will and Testament in manner & form following.

First of principally I bequeath my Soul to almighty God trusting
through the Merit of Jesus Christ to receive full pardon of Deserption
of all my Sins as for my Body that to be buried at the Discretion of my
Executor hereafter Named. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son
William Cox all my Tract of Land that I bought of Abram Childress
also Two Negroes Named Siger Nan Ivan Aggoy Inde to him of his Heirs and
Aggoy for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son Benjamin
Cox half the Tract of Land whereon I now live with the Manner
Plantation also One Negro Boy Named Matt and One Negro girl Named
Aggo also One Negro Boy Named Wat to him of his Heirs of Aggoy for
ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son Edward Cox the
other half of my Tract of Land that I now live on also Three Negro Boys
Named Jack Lewis Cain to him his Heirs of Aggoy for ever. Item I give &
bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Cox Two Negro Boys Named
Isaac & also One Negro girl Named Dilly to her & her Heirs of Aggoy
for ever. Item my Will is that my Stock of cattle Hogs hens & Sheep &c.
Equally divided amongst my Three Sons of youngest Daughter Elizabeth
to them their Heirs of Aggoy for ever. Item I give unto my beloved Daughter
Sarah Ward Five Shillings Sterling to her & her Heirs of Aggoy for ever
Item my Will is that my Son William Cox have all my Estate that I
have not already gave away but my Three Beds which I desire may be
divided between my Youngest Children Edward Benjamin & Elizabeth to
them their Heirs of Aggoy for ever. Item my Will is that all my Estate be
kept together till all my just Debts & funeral charges be paid. Lastly I do
appoint my Son William Cox and my Friend Thomas Gopling Mead
Thomas my Not & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
nearly revoking all former Wills by me made Declaring this & only this
to be my last Will & Testament in Testimony of which I have hereunto
set my hand & seal affixed my Seal this 8th Day of April 1769.
