& ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally  
and first of all I give my soul into the hands of almighty  
God that gave it me first my Body I recommend to the  
earth to be buried in a Christian Decent Manner at the discre-  
tion of my executors not Doubting but at the general Resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God and  
therefore Touching such Wordly Estate as it hath pleased the  
almighty God to blesse me with I do give Devise & dispose of the  
same in the following Manner & Form Item I do hereby give  
& bequeath unto my Dear & well Beloved Wife Averillah Foster  
one Negroe Boy Named Griggory & one Negroe Boy Named  
Billie & one Negroe Boy Named Pompey & one Negroe girl  
Named Silla her & her Increase During her life or widow-  
hood though not to be excepted to fail for any Debt or Debts and  
after her Death or Marriage to be equally Devised with all  
my other goods & chattels & land among my eleven children  
except my Negroe Fellow Peter and my young mare I leave to  
be sold at Publick Auction to the highest Bidder to pay off my  
Debts all other Estate whatsoever to be equally Devised among  
my eleven children to them & their Heirs for ever Henry Foster,  
Mark Foster, John Foster, Sarah Garnet Foster, Simon West Berry  
Foster, Rachel Foster, Joel Foster, Edmund Foster, Philadelphia T. Jr.  
Anthony Foster, Mary Foster & if any of my children should  
die without a lawfull heir then their part to be equally devised  
amongst the rest & further more I desire that as fast as my boys  
arrive to the age of twelve years of age they may be put to school  
two years & then bound to a trade and likewise my Daughters  
to have one year Schooling & likewise do appoint David Wills  
John Harker Thomas Jerry & Joseph Blaylock Esq: for to Manage  
I settle my Affairs In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal my Seal this Eleventh Day of February in the Year  
of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Sixty four.

Bunch Item I bind to my Wife Lucy children Two Hundred Acres  
of Land wherein she now liveth for & During her natural life Item  
Item I give to my said Wife all that part of my Estate as is mentioned  
already in a bond to her Trustee Henry Hopson I give them mentio-  
ned things to her & her Heirs Appointed by her for ever also the  
Increase of the said Stock as is in that said Bond which I have
