In the Name of God Amen I John Thomas of the parish of Tillet in County of Albemarle being Weak in body but of sound Memory (blessed be God) do this Twenty fourth day of February in the Year of our Lord 1761 make & publish This my last Will & Testament in Manner following I give & commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who I love & My body to the earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of My Executors hereafter Named Item after my Just & lawful Debts

be paid by my Executors I send unto my Loving Wife Wifred Thomas the house & plantation
 Wheron I now Live during her Natural Life Together with all my household goods & Furniture
 & What Stock I owe & Accept Such of them as are hereafter mentioned as legacies to my
 Children which are as follow Item I Give & bequeath to my son Charles Thomas one hundred
 Acres of Land lying & being in the County of Albemarle on the South side the Fluvanna River
 Joining to Mr Allen Howard to him & his heirs forever Item I Give & bequeath to my son
 Charles Thomas one Gray Mare Item I Give & bequeath to my son ~~Charles~~ Thomas after his
 Mothers Decease the Tract of Land Wheron I now live Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter
 Judith one Gray horse Item my Will & pleasure is that when my Daughter Betty Smith
 Thomas shall Attain the age of XVIII Years Then I bequeath her a riding Broom Item
 to my Daughter Anne Thomas when she Attains the age of XVII Years Then I bequeath
 her a riding Broom Item my Will & pleasure further is that at my Wifes Decease all my
 household Furniture Stock Cattle hogs & Whatsoever be remaining be Equally Divided
