four hundred Acres of Land I sold him provided he pays the
Consideration for the same According to Contract from my Will
& Desire is that my mother Priscilla Freeland have the sole Use

of my Negroes Anice, Batt & Nan & all the rest of my Estate during her
 her Natural life & after her Death to go & be divided in manner following
 Item I Give & bequeath to be Equally Divided Between the Children of
 Phillip Pondleton by my sister Spice the aforesaid Negroes Maurice, Batt
 & Nan & their Increase & the rest of my Estate I send my Mother &
 Nothing therein to be Construed to Molest her while she lives I do
 Nominate & appoint Mace Freeland Executor to this my Last Will &
 Testament & do acknowledge Publish & declare this the same in manner & some
