this my last will & Testament in manner and form following First I Commend my
Soul to Almighty God living in the Kingdom of my Father Jesus for a full
Pardon of all my sins and my Body to be buried at the discretion of my
Executors and after my worldly Estate after my Just Debts are paid I dispose of it
in manner & form following

I Give by my Father and Mother William & Hannah Moore one Tract of
Land whereon I now live Containing one hundred & fifty Acres together
with all my Personal Estate to be by them Possessed at once as the shall see
and then to be disposed of as shall be hereafter mentioned

I Give to my sister Mary Mallox one feather Bed and furniture
to be possessed after my Father and Mother Death by her & her heirs forever
I Give to my sister Judith Pearce one feather Bed & furniture to be
Possessed after my Father & Mother death by her & her heirs forever

I Give to my Brother Benjamin Moor and my Sister Elizabeth Moor
Crainford my whole Estate of Land Negroes and Stock of all kinds except the
two Bares given already to my sister Mallox & Pearce to be Equally divided
between them in the manner following which is for my Brother Benjamin

to have his heirs or Executors at my Father & Mother Death to divide my
Estate into two Equal Parts and allow my Sister Elizabeth Crainford
her heirs or Executors to have the first Choice of Either of the Parts to be
Possessed after my Father & Mother Death by them and their Heirs forever

I Give to my Brother William Moor and my Brother John Moor
my sister Mary Mallox and my sister Judith Pearce twenty five pounds
Current Money of Virginia a Piece to be paid Out of my Estate after my
Father & Mother death by my Executors

and I do constitute and appoint Benjamin Moor & John Crainford
Executors of this my last will & Testament Revoking and annulling
all Other wills by me made heretofore Witness my hand & Seal this 17th Day
of December 1767
