 do make this my Last will & Testament in manner and form
 following that is first I Recommend my Soul into the hands of

 Item I give & Bequeath unto my Loving Son Patrick Napier
 four hundred Acres of Land known by the name of the Black Church
 Land & whereon the same stands to him & his heirs for ever

Item I give & Bequeath unto my Loving Son Peter Napier
 Three hundred & Sixty Acres of Land joining the Church Land
 wth Stone & Marble Stone to him & his heirs for ever

Item I give unto my Loving Son Joseph Fox Napier my
 Plantation whereon I now live & four hundred Acres of Land
 he paying unto his Brother Peter Napier one hundred
 pounds when y^e 80 y^r shall arrive to the age of Twenty Two
 Also my will is if either of my two younger Sons Peter or
 Joseph Fox Napier should die before they come to the age of
 Twenty One that then it should be Divided between the other two

As if it should please god that two of my Three youngest
 Sons should die, Patrick Peter or Joseph Fox Napier, that then
 the Surviving Son should Inherit my Lands

Item I give to my Loving Daughter Mary Perwin Napier
 Negroe Violet to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give to my Loving Daughter Elizabeth Claiborne
 Napier, Negroe Nell to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give unto my Loving Daughter Anne Fox Napier
 Negroe Fanny to her & her heirs for ever & in case of either of my
 three Daughters Death, that Surviving of the three shall have
 the whole or an Equall Division

Item the Rest of my Estate both Real & Personal, I leave to my
 Loving wife Martha Napier during her life or widowhood
 & at her Death or marriage, to be Equally Divided Among
 5 Children, Patrick, Peter, Joseph Fox, Mary Perwin, Elizabeth
 Claiborne & Ann Fox Napier or their heirs Surviving, Respe-
 ctively all other wills by me made, Inwitness whereof
