This Will was presented in Court & proved by the Oath of Patrick Napier  
a witness thereto & a court held for said County the 1<sup>st</sup> June 1765  
was further proved by the Oath of W<sup>m</sup> Payne a witness but did not hear him  
publish the same, Anne Davis being sworn saith she heard the aforesaid  
publish it at the time Patrick Napier was called upon to swear and ordered  
to be recorded. On the Motion of Roger Thompson who made & attested  
according to Law probat is granted &c on giving security whereupon he  
with Peter P. Trent his security entered into & acknowledged their  
Bond according to Law.

Seven hundred & Sixty five & in the Fifth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George  
the Third over Great Britain France & Ireland King I Samuel Arnold of the parish of  
Saint Arms in the County of Alleghany in the Colony of Virginia a Gentleman being  
sick & weak of body but of good & perfect mind & memory thankes be to God do make  
this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say) first I bequeath  
my Soul & Spirit into the hands of Almighty God my Heavenly Father by whom of his  
merit mercy & grace I trust to be saved & received into Eternal Rest thro' the Death of  
my Saviour Jesus Christ in whose precious Blood I set the only hope of my Salvation  
my wretched body in hope of a joyful Resurrection I commit to the Earth to be buried  
with such charges & in such place as my dear Wife Martha Arnold shall think  
good. & touching the Distribution of my worldly Goods I dispose of the same as  
followeth. First I will as all I justly owe be truly paid Item I give & bequeath all  
the rest of my Estate both Real & Personal, Viz Land & Goods to my well beloved  
Wife Martha Arnold & her Heirs & Assigns for ever. & lastly I do appoint my dearly  
beloved Wife Martha Arnold my Sole & whole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament  
& do Ratify & Confirm this to be my last Will & Testament hereby making null &  
void all former Wills & Testaments by me hitherto made. In witness whereof  
I the said Samuel Arnold do hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day & year  
first above written.
