following Imprimis I recommend my Soul to Almighty God who gave it hoping  
for his mercy through the merits and mediation of his Son our Saviour Jesus  
Christ and my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Decent and Christian like  
manner Item I Give to my dearly beloved Wife Jane all my personal Estate  
during her Natural Life to be applied towards the support of herself and my  
Children till my said Children shall respectively arrive to the age of twenty-one  
Years or until my Daughters shall be married which shall first happen  
in Order to the further support of my Wife and Children my Will and Desire  
that my Wife have full Power and Authority to sell three hundred acres of  
Lying and bearing State River between the Lands of William Weston and  
Anthony Tunning and that she purchase Slaves with the Money so  
from such Sale and place them on such of my Land as she shall think most  
convenient for cropping and apply the Profits of such Slaves Labour for the  
support and maintenance of herself and Children above mentioned  
Item also mentioned and that my Wife after my Children shall arrive to the age of  
twenty-one years or after my Son arrives to that age and my Daughters marry me  
desire if what Negroes Stock and other Personal Estate she shall then be possessed  
of to my Children in such sort as she shall think most proper Item I give and  
desire unto my Son Thomas Ballow the Tract of Land and Plantation wherein Ind  
lue together with twelve hundred acres of Land joining to the same which hundred  
hundred acres of Land were subuid for to him and his Heirs for ever Item I give  
desire unto my Daughter Dorothy Ballow eight hundred acres of Land lying and  
bearing in the County of Albemarle on the Branches of black Water Creek being Part  
of my Share of a Survey between Col<sup>r</sup> Joshua Toy and others made in Pursuance  
of an Order of Council to her and her Heirs for Ever Item I Give unto my  
Daughter Miles Ballow eight hundred acres of Land lying and bearing in the County  
of Albemarle on the Branches of black Water Creek being other Part of my Share of  
above mentioned Survey to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give and desire  
unto my Daughter Jane Ballow eight hundred acres of Land lying and bearing

being in the County of Albemarle on the Branches of Black Water and being another  
Part of my Share of the above mentioned Survey to her and her Heirs forever  
Item I give and Devise all the Rest and Residue of the above mentioned Survey  
if there should any fall to my Share more and above the aforementioned two  
hundred and four hundred acres given to my three Daughters to my son Thomas  
Ballow and his Heirs forever I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear Wife  
Cecilia and our Samuel Gleadow and John Nicholas Executors of this my  
last Will and Testament hereby revoking another will by me heretofore made  
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Thirteenth  
Day of August in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and fifty  
two

Testament in manner following Impressing I give and devise to my son John  
Bates to him and his Heirs for ever my two hundred & fifty acres of Land on  
the Fluvanna side whereon I now live and also my three hundred acres of Land  
joining the Land above named and Phineas Gloucesters Land Item I give and  
devise to my son Isaac Bates to him and his Heirs for ever my four hundred  
acres of Land on the Branches of Randolph Creek which I purchased of  
Samuel Brainerd Item I give and devise to my third Daughter Anne Bates Lucy  
Bates and Elizabeth Bates to them and their Heirs for ever all my eleven  
hundred and seventeen acres of Land on Randolph Creek joining the lines  
of John Cannon John Dunnington and Stephen Hughes to be equally divided
