wife (the one third of all my Clear Estate after all my Just Debts
is paid to gether with funeral Charges & the Costs of Administration
of the Legacies hereafter Mentioned to be Said off before my beloved
wife Sarah have her third of my Clear Estate & then for her &
her heirs & assigns freely to Enjoy the same third I am I Give &
bequeath to my wellbeloved Son Samuel Man the sum of ten
Shillings Current Money to be raised out of my Estate I am I
Give my Wellbeloved Daughter Elizabeth Robertson the sum of
Ten Shillings Current Money I am I Give my well beloved
Daughter Margaret Man one Young Gray Mare Great with
Colt & her side Saddle & one Young heifer which she says
belong to together with one Feather Bed & Furniture one new bed
tick her wheel & in twenty Shillings in Current Money to her
heirs & assigns I am I Give my Will & I Order my Executors
to sell the Plantation I now live on for to raise money for to pay my
Debts I am I Give my well beloved Son Nathaniel Man one small
Entry of Land Touching the Land of my Son Samuel Man together with
all & singular the Remainder of my Clear Estate after the above
Mentioned Legacies & Debt is paid I Give & bequeath to him his
heirs & assigns freely to be possessed & Enjoyed & I do hereby utterly
Disavow Revoke & Disannul all & Every Other former Testament
Wills & Legacies Requests of Executors by me in any wise before
