Sound Memory Blessed be God as this fourteenth day of March in the
Year of our Lord God One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty one and
Publish this my last Will and Testament in manner Following
that is to say Principally and first of all I give and recommend
My soul into the hands of God that gave it and for my Body I recommend
it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like & Decent Manner at
the Direction of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the General
Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God
and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God
to bless me in this Life I give devise and Dispose of the same in the following
Manner and Form after my Lawful Debts be Paid. I Impart I give
and Bequeath to my Dearly & Well Beloved Wife Rachel Morrisson
The Plantation I now live on and all the Appurtenances thereunto
belonging as far as the Main Channel of the River during her life
or Widowhood & at her Death or Marriage I give and Bequeath the
same to my Beloved son Ezra Morrisson to his heirs and assigns forever.
I am I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Son Joseph Morrisson the
Land on the North side of the River together with an Entry on the stoney
Level and one on the Spring hill the former Containing 200 Acres and
the latter 290 Acres to him and his heirs forever. I am I give to my well
Beloved Daughter Eve Morrisson one Carter Tract of 200 Acres of Land
lying on the Branches of Ruttedges Creek to her her heirs or assigns
for ever for to enjoy the same at age or Marriage. I am I give to my
well beloved Daughter Fizzah Morrisson one Carter tract of 200 Acres of
Land lying on the Branches of the Mill Creek to her her heirs or assigns
for ever for to enjoy the same at age or Marriage. And I likewise Give to
my above said Dearly and Well beloved Wife Rachel Morrisson all my
Negrees and Movables to be Disposed of According to her Discretion together
